In 1997, the Canadian Galloway Association hosted a meeting of World Galloway & Belted Galloway breeders in Calgary, Canada to float the idea of establishing a World Galloway Conference event. At this meeting Ole Grubbe, invited Galloway and Belted Galloway breeders from around the world to Germany the following year.

The following year, in Alsfeld, Germany the 1st World Galloway meeting was held, hosted by the German Galloway Association. At this meeting it was agreed to host a World Galloway meeting every 2 years. 2 delegates from each Member Association voted to appoint the President & Secretary for the next 2 years and to accept invitations from Galloway & Belted Galloway associations to host future conferences.
